- ❖ **2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2010:** School closed for Easter Break. Sister Molly arranged for juice for the children who went visiting the churches for Good Friday. Prayer services were also held in the school premises itself.
- ❖ **4<sup>th</sup> April, 2010:** Being Easter Day, Sister Molly arranged biryani for the children. During tea she also gave them chocolates, cakes, sweets. All the children were very happy and they enjoyed themselves a lot.

Sister bought umbrellas for the children as it was hot during April. In this month everyone started their new session so sister bought them their stationeries and uniforms and those children who travel by metro were given tickets by Sister.

Sister always takes a lot of care for the children. Despite her hectic schedule she always finds time to come and talk to the children if they are facing any problems in studies or anything else, she takes out time to teach them English and she also advises them to do the right thing.

- ❖ **8<sup>th</sup> May, 2010:** On this day ten visitors from Canada had come to visit the Rainbow Home. Sister Molly also joined in this meeting.

All the children were introduced to them their work in the school was shown to the visitors. The visitors taught them a dance which they had performed very well. They spent time talking to the children and left at around 4:30pm.

- ❖ On this day four girls from Khalsa went home, one remained and left on the **14<sup>th</sup>**. The rest of the school were having their unit test and on the 14<sup>th</sup> of May results of all the Loreto children were out. Everyone did well, except 3-4 girls.
- ❖ By the **14<sup>th</sup>** May , our Rainbow Homes was closed for the summer vacations. Seventy of the girls left for home however few were left and left on the **18<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup>** of the month. There are around nine , who will be spending their vacations here as they have got no place to go.
