**24<sup>th</sup> March. 2010-** Michael sir had visited the Rainbow school with three of his friends and his daughter. The girls put on “henna” for her which she liked a lot. Two of the friends, Sasha and Marshall taught the girls “The Michael Jackson Dance” which entertained them a lot. At around 6:15pm they had all left.
