SHORT GOSSIP WITH EDITOR

We have very happy news i.e. our boy child, Ganesh Bista is doing School Leaving Certificate (SLC) exam. After this exam, he'll be graduated student and will rehab in his own family.

(Ganesh Bista, 16 years old, is physically challenged boy. He is appearing in the SLC. He came here in NMG Home at the age of 7 years. He has been with NMG from the start in February 2000 and he is the first child in NMG Home to come out in the SLC exam.)



Interviewer: How are you?

Ganesh: *Everything is all right here.*

Interviewer: As you are appearing in the SLC exam in this year, how are you feeling?

Ganesh: *I'm feeling great and happy too. At the moment, I'm going to complete my schooling.*

Interviewer: How are your exams going on?

Ganesh: *pretty good.*

Interviewer: How do you feel about NMG?

Ganesh: *It's been 8 years that I have been staying here. It feels like I am with my family in my own home.*

Interviewer: How was your physical problem before coming here?

Ganesh: (...with sadness) *The problem was worse then. But after taking regular Physiotherapy in NMG Therapy Centre, I have become physically better.*

Interviewer: How is the behaviour of other normal friends and teachers in the school?

Ganesh: *Their behaviour is nice. Their nice behaviour makes me feel as if I'm physically sound.*

Interviewer: What do you do after your SLC exam?

Ganesh: *Immediately, after my SLC, I want to go to my village and meet my family & relatives. After that I will come back. I also want to take computer trainings.*

Ganesh: *I wish to study Science after I passed my SLC. But I don't know whether I can study Science or not.*
