



NEPAL MATRI GRIHA (NMG)

Home Management Program

(Mid. Term Report from 15 January 2007 to 15 July 2007)

Nepal Matri Griha (NMG) is one of the non profits making non governmental social service organization that mainly concerns with children issues.



NMG Home is one of the significant programs of Nepal Matri Griha which aspires to provide residence for the children who are orphan, destitute and mentally and physically challenged. As there are hundreds of children around the country who are deprived of safe shelter, education, medical treatment and entertainment which are the vital elements of life, NMG shows its presence among them. Accordance their objective, NMG has been running a Home for the extremely needy children from its establishment. At present there are 17 children (10 male and 7 female) including 4 children having mental and physical weaknesses.

Daily Activities

- **Schooling:**
There are 17 children who are sheltered in NMG Home and all of them are getting good education in different



schools. Out of 17 children, 11 children go to North Pont Academy, 1 goes to Third Eye Academy, 1 Alpine Sambhabi Academy, 3 studies NMG School, 1 goes to NMG Therapy Center. These children are studying from class one to class 10.

- **Tuition class:** NMG gives its best priority to the education of the children. Every morning and evening 2/2 hour tuition classes have



been managed for them.

- **Sports:** It needs daily physical activities that entertain the children and



help for the efficient mental and physical growth. Therefore they are

given time for the sports and other refreshment activities to avoid idle and monotonous time. After they return from school they play for some time to refresh their mental and physical condition.

Special Activities

- **Picnic:** Every year special educational excursion and picnic have been organized for the children. The major objective to manage such type of program is to provide them a chance to collect additional knowledge about various things and create an opportunity for the special entertain which is a different experience than they get in their daily life activities. This year they had been taken to picnic in bakery café, New Baneshwor where they ate delicious food and collected new experience.



- **Celebrating Teej:** The children participated in Teej festival, which falls on August every year. This is a festival especially for the women. According to Hindu culture the married women take whole day fasting for the good health and prosperity of their



husband while unmarried girls pray to god for getting good husband in future. However everybody, children and adult female celebrate the festival that tied them into unity.

- **Birth Day:** Every year all the home children get together for celebrating their birthday. It is not possible to organize birthday festive for every one individually, therefore a single day has been chosen for the home



childrens' birthday. In this occasion they obtain best wishes from friends, elders and the donors. They enjoyed by dancing singing and eating whatever prepared for them.

- **Gardening:** For the children NMG creates different opportunities and occasions to be participated and learn more practically. Therefore the children were given chance to know about gardening. On this occasion they learned how to plant seeds, dig land, use fertilizers and care the garden properly.
